## CT Scan Patient Prep Information

All exams ordered with IV contrast require a 4-hour fast (nothing to eat or drink). You may have a small amount of water to take your medications or brush your teeth.

Certain CT scans require you to drink oral contrast beforehand. We will add the oral contrast prep time to your appointment time.

Lab work: If your CT scan requires IV contrast, you may need to have labs drawn to check how well your kidneys are working. If you are <u>60 years old or older</u>, <u>diabetic</u>, or <u>have kidney problems</u>, <u>including kidney cancer</u>, ask your doctor if you need lab work.

If you have had lab work outside of Frisbie, please have these drawn and sent to Frisbie Memorial Hospital's Imaging department at least 5 days before your appointment.

Allergies: Please make sure to discuss with your doctor any allergies you have so they can give you the proper medication prep beforehand.
